Scrutineering


We have had a query about front and rear stone tray rubbers. Here is some information courtesy of Barry Black. Only the front bumper stone shield has rubber bumpers. There is none in the rear stone shield. The front stone rubber bumpers are on each side before the centre dip and about 1" in from the outside edge of shield ends. They sit under the bumper bar.

Barry has seen both shields bolted on to the body with wind lacing between the body and the shield which is not correct. The Rear shield had a paper type gasket between the body and the shield but you don't know it is there until you unbolt the shield. The rear stone shield had material stapled to the edge under the bumper bar from each end to the bumper bar iron cut out to stop flying stones hitting the rear bumper inside curve and then coming back to hit the body above the tray. Barry has seen this on the 48 shields but he hasn't been able to see if this continued on the FJ shields. Barry has never seen this material intact on a car but you know it was there as small bits are left under the staples on the rear shield edge. Photos are below:
